


- 1- 1c cross RH | cast (2c up); turn 1¼ RH to promhold facing M side
- 9- 1c Rsh ½Reel3 with 2M+3M; Rsh ½Reel3 with 3W+2W, 1c finish in centre facing 3W (now in 1W pl)
- 17– 1c set to 3W pulling Rsh back | set to 2W; set to 2M | 1c set to 3M while {2} 3c+2c set advancing into
- 25- 3c+1c+2c Allemande

- 1- 1c+2c S&Link; 1c+3c S&Link. (to 2,3,1)
- 9- 2c+3c+1c advance {1} and retire {1} | turn BH ½ and remain in the middle: All set to P | All swivel R to dance out to opposite sides (2x,3x,1x), ready for
- Two hands of G-Chain (2c cross to start) to (1x,2,3); 1c+2c S&Link, 1c finish BtoB in the middle facing opposite side as for DTr (no hands).




25– All advance (1c to sideline, 2c+3c meet P) {1}, retire {1} | all advance and swivel R (1c to 2plx, 2c+3c into BtoB in the middle); All A{1} & R{1} again | 1c cross RH while{2} 2c+3c advance to sideline and swivel R (2,1,3).

note: For [25-28] the original texts say no hands, and pass; in the Book 23 version hands are often held, steps are very small

- 1– 1c Rsh Reels3 on opposite sides, 1M starts across top (Rsh to 2W), 1W crosses down (Lsh to 3M) (to 1x,2,3)
- 9– 1c Rsh Reels3 on own sides, 1W starts across top, 1M crosses down, end in 1pos NHJ (1,2,3)




- 17- 1c NHJ set to 2W | move round in PdB to face 2M; set to 2M | retire in PdB to 1pl
- 25- 1c+2c set | ½ RHA; set | ½ LHA to places
- 33- 1c cross RH | cast off one (2c up); 1c turn LH 1½ (to 2,1,3)
- **41–** 2c+1c R&L.

Alternative for [1-8]: 1c ends on own side. See 101 SCD and Manual

- **9–** 1M followed by 2M+3M repeat clw round the W
- 17- 1c facing 2c set | change place RH; set | change place LH ready for




- 25— 1c+2c Poussette, 1c finish BtoB in the middle facing own side for
- 33- DTr, 1c finish facing W side NHJ 1W above 1M
- 1c dance out between 2W & 3W, 1W casts up and 1M casts down, meet in the middle; cast as before, between 2M & 3M, finish in 2pl



- 9- Turn CPCP, to face 1cnrs
- 17- 1c set to and turn 1cnrs BH; set to and turn 2cnrs BH
- 25- Reels3{6} on the sides (Lsh to 1cnr) | 1c cross RH to 2pl.

- 25- 1W+2M cross LH | 1M+2W & 1W+3W cross RH; 1M+3M & 1W+4M cross LH | 1M+4W cross RH (2,3,4,1).



[25-32] represent tacking the ship, therefore no polite turns

- 17-- All W cross in front of opposite M, dance behind next M; RHA, joining P for
- **25--** All Promenade once round clw (but see note)
- 1c+3c (W following M) dance on 1 place clw and in (M round M, W round W) to face next couple; set to and turn that person RH
- 41-- Reels4 across
- **49--** Fig8, 1c round 2c, 3c round 4c
- 57-- 1c+3c LHA; 1c/3c dance out Lsh round 2c/4c (M round M, W round W) and cclw to places
- **65--96** 2c+4c repeat bars 33-64
  - **97--** All Promenade once round clw (but see note)
- 105-120 The Men repeat [9-24] cclw with LHA in the centre
  - 121-- Circle8 RIGHT and back (see note)

Note: This crib follows the current way of dancing. In the original instructions, the promenade [25-32] is cclw. Bill Hamilton said in 'hindsight' this promenade should be clw, but preferred not to change the official instructions. Bill disapproved of another variant, where the circle [121-128] is continued to the R only.



- 1– 1c cross RH | cast off (2c up); 1c+3c RHA, finish as pairs 1M+3W & 3M+1W facing out on W/M side in promhold
- 9- Pairs+ 2c+4c Rsh ½Reels3 on sides; pairs meet & take P in promhold for Lsh ½Reels3 on sides
- 17- Meet and repeat (as pairs Rsh ½Reels3); with P Lsh ½Reels3)
- 25– 1c (passing inside) turn 3c 1½ Easy Hand; 1c cross and passing inside turn 4c EH 1½ (to 2,3,4,1)



- 17-24 1s followed by 2s dance down, 2s followed by 1s dance up to 1st/2nd places
- 25-32 2s+1s dance R&L


- 1- 1c cross RH while{2} 2c (starting in) +3c change place on the sides EH | Mirror Reels3{6} on the sides, 3c (in 2pl) starting in and up, 1c ends facing out (1x,3,2)
- 9- 1c cast off **while**{2} 3c dance to top giving NH | 1c ½ Fig8 L (1W up, 1M down) | 1c 1¼ turn LH (1M now below 1W)
- **17–** 3c+1W & 1M+2c RHA (Teapots R), to sidelines; 3c+1M & 1W+2c LHA (3,1,2)
- **25** 3c+1c+2c the Knot (2,1,3)

- 1c cross RH | cast off (2c up); cross LH and cast L round 4cnr to take 1cnr on R in promhold
- 9\_ Promenade ½ round cclw and drop 1cnr at opposite corner while{4} 2cnrs A&R diagonally; 1c turn 13/4 LH to 2cnrs



- Repeat with 2cnrs while {4} 1cnrs A&R; 1c turn 11/4 LH to face 1cnr pos 17-
- ½Reel4 with 1cnrs, pass Rsh; ½Reel4 with 2cnrs, crossing Rsh to 2pl

this follows the original instructions. Those who find the time short for crossing on [31-32] can try an easier choreography, also flowing better into 2nd turn, as follows:

- Repeat with 2cnrs while {4} 1cnrs A&R; 1c turn 1¾ LH to face 3cnr (= 1cnr person)
- 25- ½Reel4 with 1cnrs, pass Rsh and face 4cnr; ½Reel4 with 2cnrs, finish in 2pl

### 8x32 Reel

A three couple dance in a four couple set Tune: The Clan Gathering by Pat Clark

- 1 4 First couple with second woman and second man with third couple dance right hands across once round.
- 5 8 First man dances across the set, casts off behind first woman, dances in front of second woman to third place on the opposite side, while third woman dances across the set, casts up behind third man, dances in front of second man to top place on the man's side.
- 9 12 Third, first, and second women at the top and second, first and third men at the bottom, dance left hands across once round.
- 13 16 First woman dances across the set, casts off behind third woman, in front of second man to third place on opposite side, while third man dances across the set, casts up behind first man in front of second woman into top place on the woman's side.
- 17 20 Third and first couples dance half a double figure of eight round second couple, third couple starts by casting off and first couple by crossing up.
- 21 24 Third couple casts off to third place on own side and sets in third place, while first couple dances up with nearer hands joined, to the top and casts off into second place (second couple steps up on bars 23&24).
- 25 32 Second, first, third couples dance six hands round and back.
